After ten minutes, the pain had only gotten worse, so I called 911. The EMT's arrived and checked me out and suggested that I go to the hospital. I had four EKG's and they all were good. My blood enzymes were elevated so they kept me overnight for observation.

The next morning, the Cardiologist said that I needed a heart catheterization to determine what was going on. They found one major blockage and removed it and put in one stint. Then the news came that I do have some heart damage.

So many people praying and God honored their prayers.

I feel Great. I just have to take it easy for a while as my heart heals.

During this episode, I was able to witness to one of the EMT's. He had some non-biblical understanding about God, and I was able to answer his questions in a way to make him rethink what he believed. I also had the opportunity to share with the Cardiologist of my faith in God and my praying for him. Even in the difficulties of life we can point people to Christ.

I know God is teaching me to slow down and he is also teaching me humility. I hope I learn these lessons well and that I will be able to share them with others.

VOLUNTEER COORDINATOR SAVANNAH BAPTIST CENTER


