Association Mission Strategist Thoughts

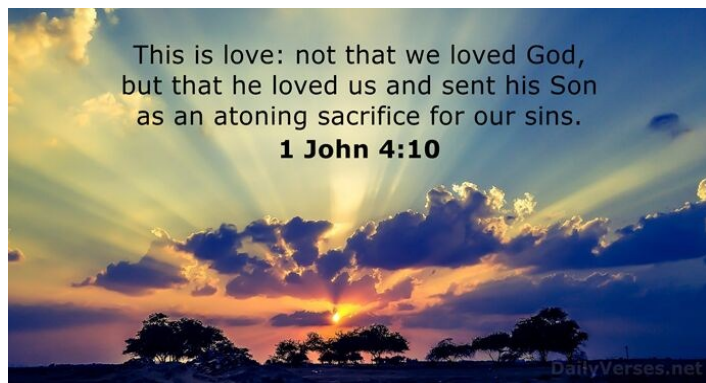
Happy New Year! Wow. We have reached 2025. I really thought that our Lord Jesus Christ would have returned before now. This must mean that He still has a lot for us to do.
