Marty's Minutes

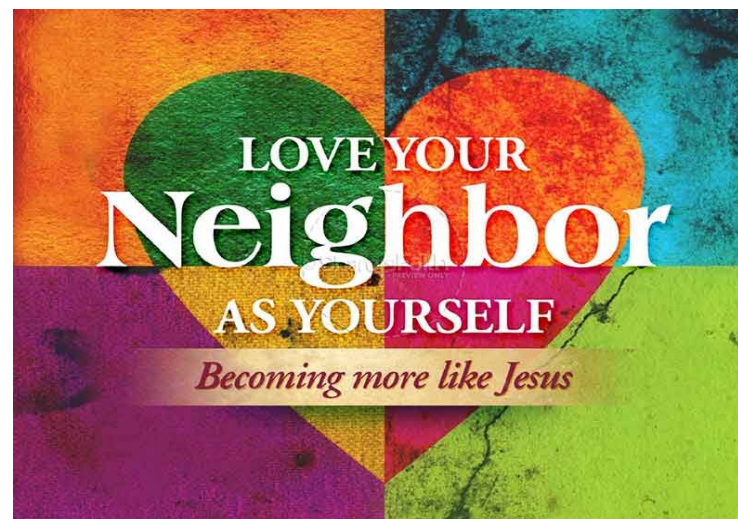
Dear SBA family,

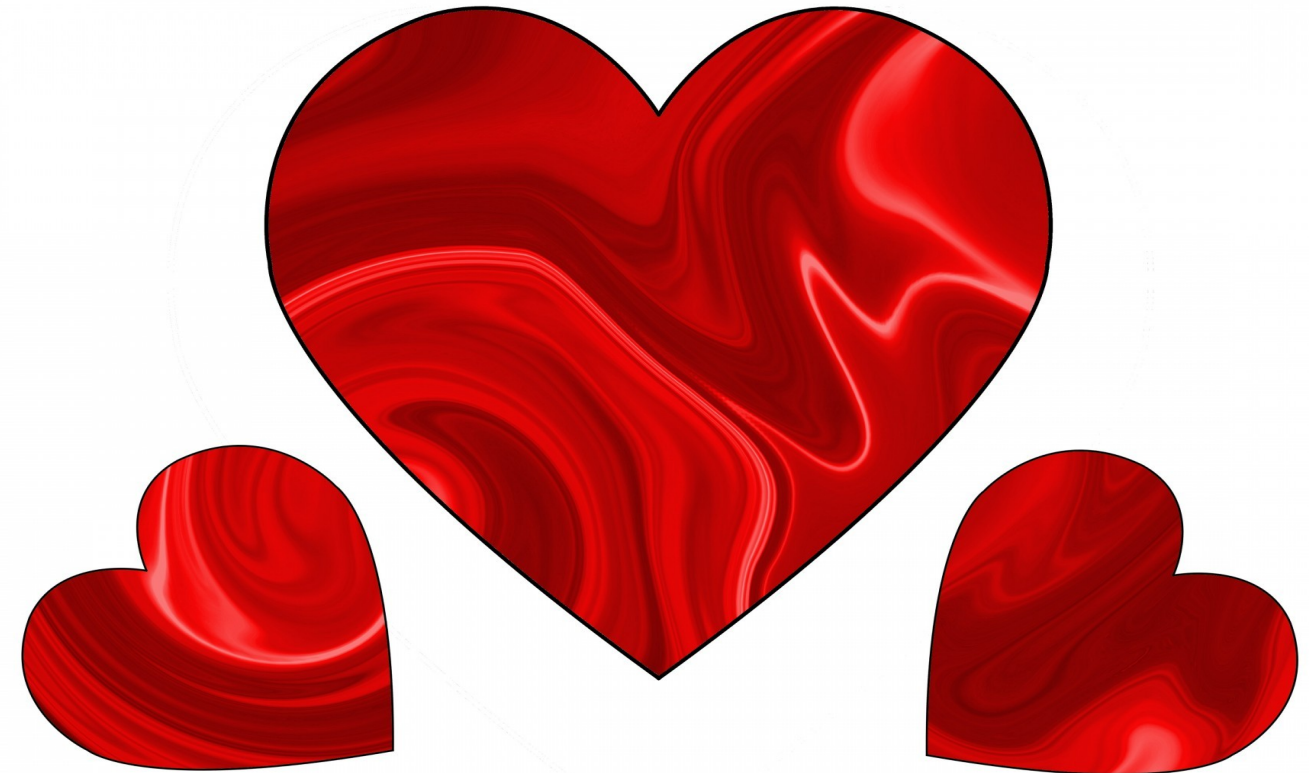
